Rather than a typical multi-family garage/yard/tag sale, this event is about **Recycling** specific types of items for other watershed and area residents to **Reuse and Repurpose**, and fostering future ACEC stewardship by **supporting youth camp experiences**.

Categories of items for sale include:

- **Fishing tackle boxes, lures, gear**
- **Kayaks and boating accessories**
- **Gardening, rain barrels, lawn/yard care tools and ornamentation, plants including milkweeds for Monarchs**
- **Bird feeding, housing, and watching**
- **Biking, riding, hiking, star gazing**
- **Natural history/sustainability books, field guides, wall art, children’s toys**
- **Cabin and nautical decor**
- **Nature folk art animals**
- **Baby care items, household goods, flat screen TV, and much miscellaneous**

HPWA members will be on hand with educational displays, for general Q&A, and socialization. Even if you can’t be there, encourage friends and neighbors to stop by.
